WIAS graduate programme call 2022

The WIAS Graduate Programme call 2022 involves the funding of (a maximum of) three PhD positions and aims to stimulate talented MSc students of WU to obtain their PhD through research at one of the WIAS chair groups on a subject of their choice. The call for the WIAS graduate programme is open to all MSc students from Wageningen University who graduate in 2022. The project proposals must be written by the candidate with feedback from the anticipated supervisors. All applications need to be accompanied by a letter of support from the main supervisor(s) of the project and must be submitted latest on 15 August 2022 to Nicole Rodenburg (nicole.rodenburg@wur.nl). TKI graduate school Green Top Sectors call

In addition to the graduate programme calls from the Wageningen graduate schools, the TKIs Agri & Food (A&F) and Horticulture & Starting Materials (T&U) will fund 4 PhD proposals written by MSc students. The aim of the programme is to facilitate innovative and high-quality scientific research within the research field of the top sectors by engaging young talented researchers at the start of their career. Environmental and Resource Economics – Module: Climate Economics 3-7 October 2022 – Location: Wageningen Campus

Short scope: What are the economic consequences of climate change? By how much should these consequences be reduced by climate change adaptation and mitigation policies? Which economic instruments are effective and efficient in stimulating a low-carbon economy and how do these instruments function? The module "Climate Economics" picks up these questions. Knowledge of "intermediate" microeconomics is beneficial, but selected readings will be provided, so PhD-candidates without this pre-knowledge can follow the course.

SAVE THE DATE for the Life Sciences Data Integration Challenge (24-28 October '22 – location: Wageningen Campus)

Organized by **Robert Smith** & **Maria Suarez Diez** (Laboratory of Systems and Synthetic Biology, Wageningen University) and The Graduate School VLAG

Current and future scientific problems require multi-disciplinary solutions and research teams composed of members from broad domain backgrounds. As an educational simulation of such an experience, the Life Sciences Data Integration Challenge 2022 is targeted at PhD candidates from life science, biotechnology, and bioinformatics fields. Over 5 days, participants will form multi-disciplinary teams to analyse a research problem using statistical and mathematical modelling pipelines, with the aim of uncovering new insights and observations. On the final day, a panel of judges will determine the winners!

If you wish to learn more about participating, or if you would like to supply a data problem to be analysed in the challenge, then please get in touch! Information about the final projects being used in the challenge will be revealed at a later date.
