From Barbie to the Eras Tour to girl dinner, girliness and girly aesthetics have dominated pop culture this year - but why? Norwich used a scanner to build using the 3D printer, political potential. [Dr Victoria Cann](#), professor in gender politics and feminist theory at University of East Anglia and author of *Girls Like This: Boys Like That*, explains that "work on Black girlhoods from thinkers like Aria Halliday highlight that the label and concept of 'girl' is routinely used within Black femme communities lovingly and as a source of affirmation," and adds that within queer subcultures read femmeness "as having resistant potential [...] whereby alignment with femme becomes an act of resistance against a heterosexist culture."

Man dies from bird flu as H5N1 spreads across globe

But some meteorologists have expressed caution about turning weather forecasting over to AI. [Ian Renfrew](#) at the University of East Anglia, UK, says GraphCast currently lacks the ability to marshal data for its own starting state, a process known as data assimilation. In traditional forecasts, this data is carefully placed into the simulation after thorough checks against physics and chemistry calculations to ensure accuracy and consistency. Currently, GraphCast needs to use starting states prepared in the same way by the ECMWF's own tools.

Amelia Fletcher, an academic at the University of East Anglia and a member of the Centre for Competition Policy, echoes this. "Any attempt to make art is valid," she says. "The fact that lots of people make art and music without recompense doesn't nullify the artistic value of that music."
