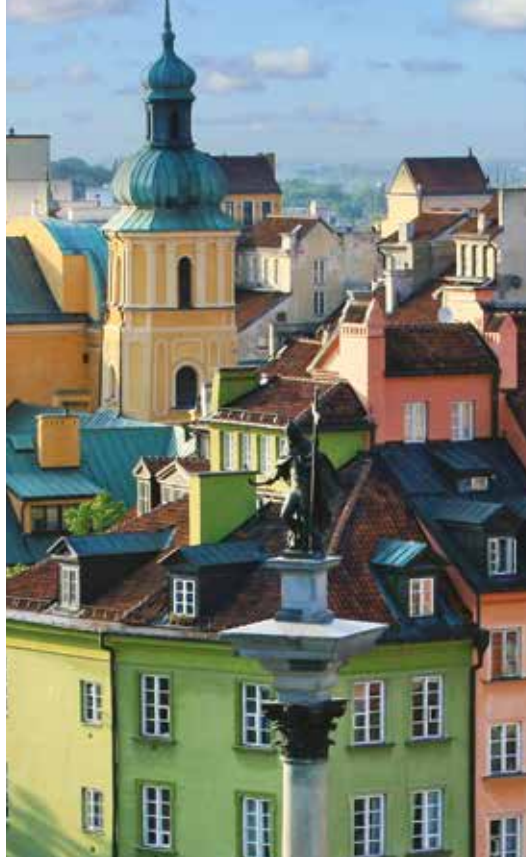

## WORKING IN POLAND

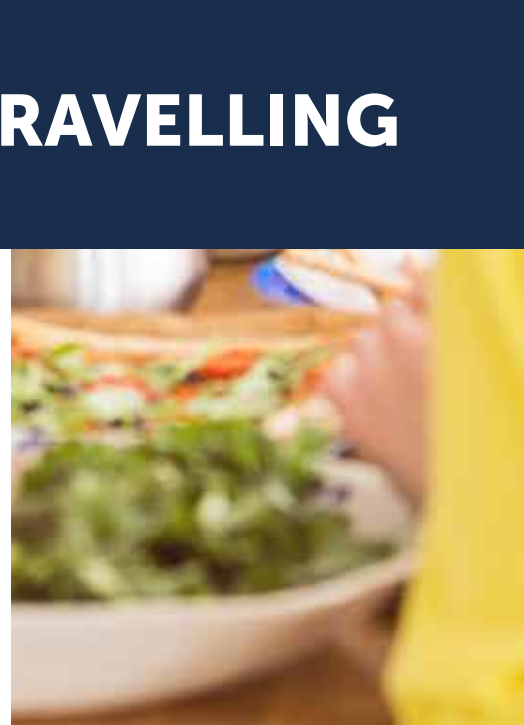

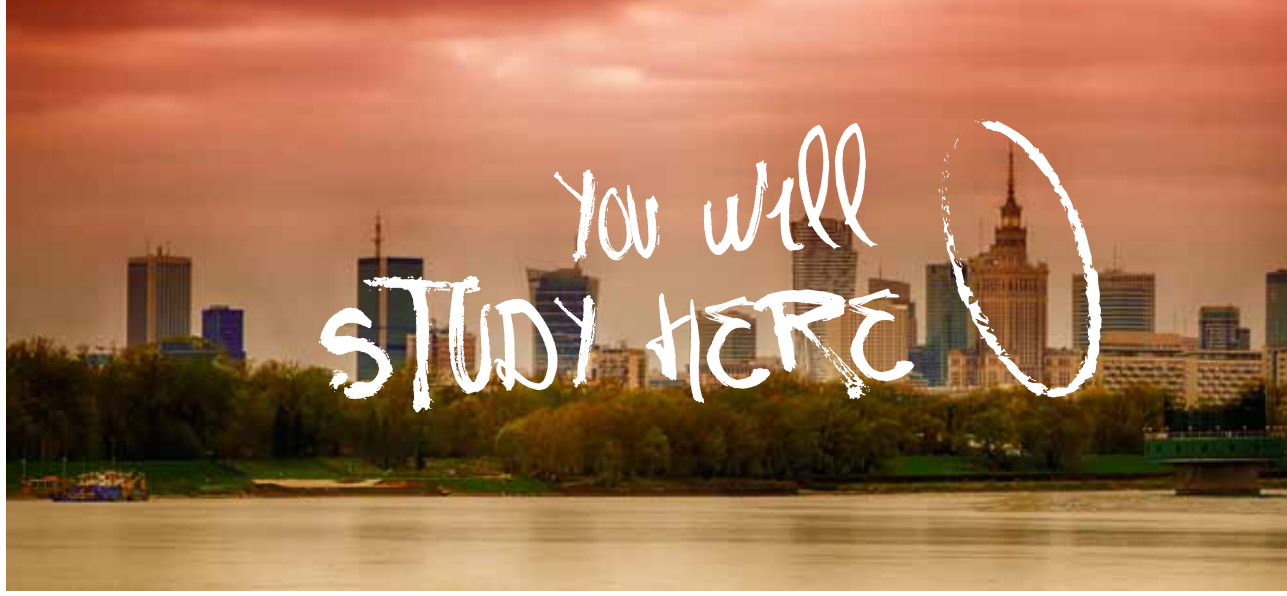
