Health Insurance:	All international students must have Medical/Health and Accident Insurance covering the duration of their studies in Thailand. If students do not have health insurance prior to arrival, they must apply at the International Studies Center (ISC) immediately upon arrival (est. 8,500 THB per year).
Guidelines for New Students	International Studies Center (ISC) is the administrative office that coordinates international education activities, offers cultural training, assists with Visa extensions, and generally advises and facilitates visiting International Students. ISC is located in the Rapee Sagarik Building, (Office of the Registrar) on the 6 th floor. *** Exchange Students must visit the ISC Office on your first arrival day to KU for register officially as a KU Student. ***
