
Wageningen landscape architects in the labour market (situation in 2022)

Alumni are divided into three groups:


- 1 Graduated between 2016 and 2019 (• graduated less than 5 years ago)

Characteristics of MLP alumni










Positions held by MLP alumni

Recent graduates often have different jobs to those who graduated some time ago. For example, recent MLP graduates mainly work as advisors. Those who have been in employment longer are more likely to work as project leaders or planning officers.



Organisations in which MLP alumni work

Recent graduates often work in different organisations to those who graduated some time ago. For example, recent MLP graduates are more likely to work at consultancy firms, while those who have been in employment longer are more likely to have jobs at local government agencies.
