Often ESB articles are picked up by other news journals that write articles that are even more accessible for broader audiences. For example, ESB articles could be translated to articles in het Financieel Dagblad which has more than 100.000 subscriptions.

Medium

Translate/convert the (published) Research report into a short article (ca. 3,000 words) for publication ESB accessible to a wider interested audience (Economists, policymakers and other stakeholders in de wooden house construction value chain (builders, architects, consumers, etc.)).
