



Stakeholder Engagement in Advancing Just and Inclusive Sustainability Transformations

Themes Submission guidelines







Themes

We are pleased to invite contributions to a planning Special Issue that extends the discussions initiated at the conference. While our conference posed the foundational question, "Can sustainability transformation be governed?", the SI aims to further the conversation by exploring, "How can meaningful stakeholder engagement ensure just and inclusive sustainability transformations?"

To help shape the content and finalize the Special Issue proposal, we invite conference participants to submit abstracts of up to 700 words. Please include a title and 5-6 keywords that capture the core themes of your submission. Authors are invited to submit their contribution within one of the **two thematic areas** below:

- (1) Paradigms refers to the ideas and worldviews that dominate solutions in sustainability governance.
 - What dominant paradigms exist in sustainability governance that shape solutions?
 - What (i.e., critical, feminist, indigenous, more-than-human) counter-paradigms exist in sustainability governance that shape solutions?
 - What power structures and epistemic hierarchies exist in sustainability governance?
- (2) Actors, practices and institutions: which actors, practices and institutions are involved in just and inclusive sustainability transformations?
 - Which actors and practices are involved in just and inclusive sustainability transformations?
 - What institutions give shape and are shaped by just and inclusive sustainability transformations?

At the moment, we are considering several journals as a possibility for the SI.
