

### Plane/Train

To arrive at Fletcher hotel – De Wageningsche Berg, you can travel by train either through Ede-Wageningen or Arnhem Central station. If you arrive at Schiphol Airport, travel time from Schiphol to the Fletcher hotel – De Wageningse Berg is approximately 90 - 110 minutes. The train station is in the basement of the Airport. There are trains every 15 minutes. Tickets are sold at the vending machines, or at the counters in the arrival hall. You can also book it online before. #### Bus

From the train station Ede-Wageningen and Arnhem Central to the Fletcher hotel – De Wageningse Berg you can take a bus. Bus 352 will take you directly from Arnhem Central to the hotel, while from Ede-Wageningen train station bus 103, 303 and 86 include a transfer in Wageningen Centre to bus 51 or 352 for the Fletcher Hotel – De Wageningsche Berg. You can buy your ticket on the bus with a debit- or credit card (no cash).

### Taxi

### Bus Hotel - Campus

If you are at the Fletcher Hotel – De Wageningsche Berg, a bus is arranged to bring you to the Leeuwenborch building. <u>You can sign up for the bus here</u>. The bus leaves at 8:30 from Hotel De Wageningsche Berg.

If you are staying in another hotel in Wageningen, you can take the bus 103 or 86 and stop at the Hoevestein bus stop (1 min walking distance to the Leeuwenborch). ### Train/Bus

For those coming from outside Wageningen, to arrive by train at the Leewenborch building on the campus of Wageningen University, you must travel until Ede-Wageningen Station and then take the bus 303 via Hoevestein (not via Campus/Forum) or the bus 86 and stop at the Hoevestein station. The Leeuwenborch building is 1 minute distance walk from there. You can plan your train travel online: <u>Home | NS</u>

• <u>Fletcher hotel-Wageningsche Berg</u> (conference location):

In case this hasn't been done yet, you can still book a room via their website. The hotel is on top of the Wageningse Berg and has a panoramic view over the Rhine riverscape. There are plenty of walking routes that bring you through the forested moraine, the budding Arboretum, lively floodplains and the river. The hotel also has a wellness and has options for bike rent.

## Restaurant and bar tips

Diner for Day 1 (16th October) is settled and will include a project diner at Restaurant Belmonte - Fletcher Hotel De Wageningsche Berg. As for the other evenings, there are several restaurants in the center of Wageningen where you could go for dinner or a drink.

- <u>Restaurant 'LEV @ De Wereld'</u> at the 5th of May Square has a historical character as it was a traveller's lodge in 1669 and transformed into a place of negotiation during the capitulation of the German occupier in 1945. It became a monument of peace and freedom.
- Soek Damascus for Syrian kitchen
- <u>Colors World Food</u> with weekly thematic options
- <u>Sa Lolla</u> and <u>Sole d'Italia</u> for Italian kitchen
- <u>Bistro Balthazar</u> or <u>Petit Louis</u> for French kitchen
- <u>Diels restobar</u>

For nightcaps, reflections and 'gezelligheid' (Dutch word for fun coziness), the <u>brown café De Zaaier</u> and <u>Het Rad van Wageningen</u> offer locally brewed spiced gin and beers.
