Each year, WIAS organizes the WIAS Science Day for the WIAS community. The overarching theme of this year's edition is "Animals in a Changing World". Climate change, biodiversity loss, and critical views on animal husbandry and consumption of animal products, force us to think about our role as animal scientists and the contributions we make in animal science. As a result, the vibrant WIAS community is adapting to these developments and deploys the latest developments in AI and sensor technology to study animals, understand their needs and behaviour and their future role in circular farming systems and biodiversity.

In this edition of the WIAS Science Day, we explicitly invite PhD candidates, post-docs and earlystage tenure trackers to present their groundbreaking research to the wider WIAS community.

#### Looking for candidates to join the Scientific Diving - Practical Course (MAE20806)

The course will be held in Krk, Croatia for a total of 12 days. The approximate dates that we'll go are: 24 July – 3 August, 2024. The costs are 2000 euro including travel, accommodation and gear rental. Expenses for food must be covered additionally. The prerequisites to join are at least 50 open water dives, a recent dive medical check, and having passed the Scientific Diving – Theoretical Course. #### **WGS Sandwich PhD Programme**

The aim of the WGS Sandwich PhD Programme is capacity building: a way for the university to reach out to like-minded scientific institutes to build international scientific networks, to facilitate exchange and to reinforce the knowledge basis of these institutes.

The grant of the WGS sandwich PhD programme covers living allowance (salary costs via a fictitious employment agreement) for a total of 18 months in Wageningen, (partial) travel costs of candidate and WU/local supervisors, visa application costs, WUR account and use of facilities.

Additional funding for a candidate is needed for the time not spent in Wageningen. The education budget and the costs for printing the thesis are not included in the budget. The WU chair group at which candidates conduct their research are expected to pay these costs.
