

Center for Unusual Collaboration (CUCo) SPARK GRANTS

Spark grants aim to stimulate unusual collaborations to address societal challenges. The grants offer initial financial support to start building a committed project team and explore the potential of an idea and/or test whether it can be taken further and developed into a project application, for an Unusual Collaborations grant or another funding scheme. Spark grants are thus a low-threshold stimulus to support connection with others outside one's own disciplinary background, to initiate collaboration around a research idea, to share knowledge and best practices, and to develop something together.

Our Spark programme consists of two phases: a series of four half-day workshops (phase one) followed by a period of time in which a research topic can be explored with a team (phase two).
