The WIAS Graduate Programme call 2023 involves the funding of one PhD position. The aim is to support a high potential and talented MSc student of WU to obtain their PhD through research at one of the WIAS chair groups on a subject of their choice. The call for the WIAS graduate programme is open to all MSc students from Wageningen University who graduate(d) between August 2022 and December 2023. The proposals must be written by the candidate with feedback from the anticipated supervisors of the project.

All applications need to be accompanied by a letter of support from the main supervisor(s) of the project and must be submitted no later than <u>15 August 2023</u> to Nicole Rodenburg.




