New WIAS director

The board of Wageningen University & Research has appointed Prof. Dr Marc Naguib as Scientific Director of the graduate school WIAS. He is to succeed Prof. Dr Hans Komen. The appointment is for 4 years, 0.5 FTE, and starts from 1 July 2024.



Prof Naguib is chair of the Behavioural Ecology Group (BHE) since 2011. His main research is on communication, development and social organization of wild animals, mainly using songbirds as model. His recent research also links to conservation biology. In addition, he is president of the Netherlands Society for Behavioural Biology (NVG). Before joining the WUR, he held positions at the NIOO-KNAW, Bielefeld University and the Freie Universität Berlin.

Prof Naguib served on the WIAS board from 2017 to 2020 and on the Wageningen University Academic Board from 2019 to 2022. Prof Naguib's vision for WIAS is to better the position of WIAS as a graduate school for all animal research.

WIAS Graduate programme 2024

The WIAS Graduate Programme call 2024 involves the funding of one PhD position. The aim is to support a high potential and talented MSc student of WU to obtain their PhD through research at one of the WIAS chair groups on a subject of their choice.

The call for the WIAS graduate programme is open to all MSc students from Wageningen University who graduate(d) between August 2023 and December 2024. The proposals must be written by the candidate with feedback from the anticipated supervisors of the project. All applications need to be accompanied by a letter of support from the main supervisor(s) of the project and must be submitted no later than 1 September 2024 to Nicole Rodenburg (nicole.rodenburg@WUR.nl). Updated Procedure for Booking Doctoral Defence Ceremony Dates

A new and improved procedure regarding the booking of doctoral defence ceremony dates will be effective from July 2024. This change will eliminate the need for the stressful event of having to book a date at the first working day of the month and the disappointment which in certain cases originated from it. From July 2024 onwards, booking a ceremony date will be possible after the approval of:

- 1. the draft thesis manuscript.
- 2. the thesis committee.

This means that in order to secure a slot, both criteria must be met.

There will be 15-week period between the time you are able to book a doctoral defence ceremony date and the first available slot. This means that only promotion slots meeting this requirement will be available in the Hora Finita ceremony calendar. Please note that this timeline is specific to the PhD trajectory and the term for which slots can be booked will change every day. The envisaged changes will be implemented to address the challenges encountered with the current procedure and to streamline the booking process, ultimately aimed at providing a more organized and less stressful experience for all involved parties.






